


The King lifted his head


**He ran to his closet, fast as he can,

Berries, veggies, yummy eats!**







What fun!

Yet every heart began to lift.






**Bird chirped, "Let's give these nuts to
Squirrel!"**


**Frog said, "And these leaves to Snail girl!"

An empty basket at their feet.






That night the King looked at the sky,

She taught him, "Kindness grows in you."






The next day, with joy so bright,

And voices shouted, “We are here!”






The soup went bubble,
